Work in Progress

I have finished the draft of a book (in Chinese) arguing for a responsibilist theory of knowledge. I show how this theory can better address the four central problems in epistemology (i.e., the skeptical challenge, the Gettier Problem, the Lottery Problem, and the Meno Problem) than evidentialism, reliabilism, and virtue epistemology. The book will be published next year.

Also, I am planning to write a book on understanding.
